

# SKI & SNOWBOARDING PROGRAM - GRADES 5 - 8

WEDNESDAYS, JAN. 3 - FEB. 7, 2024 / TROLLHAUGEN

11:30 AM - 5:00 PM

If one of these dates is cancelled, there will be an additional day of skiing on February 14th. This program is part of the students' physical education curriculum. Everyone is expected to participate. You are welcome to join them on ski days. Students eat lunch, board the bus at 11:30 am, have a lesson at 1:00 pm, and return to school by 5:00 pm. All 5th grade students are required to take lessons. 6th - 8th grade students can take lessons if needed.

If a student has a season pass, you just need to pay for the bus fee and the rental (if needed). Rental fees can be paid each week by check or cash. Or you can pay for all 6 weeks at once.
